



Jesus declares that true worship...

The woman said to Him, “I know that Messiah is coming (He who is called Christ); when that One comes, He will **declare** all things to us.”

²⁶ Jesus said to her, “I am *He*, the One speaking to you.” John 4:25-26 NASB

1. is not a place.

²⁰ Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, and yet you Jews say that in Jerusalem is the place where one must worship.” ²¹ Jesus said to her, “Believe Me, woman, that a time is coming when you will worship the Father neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem. John 4:20-21 NASB

2. starts with salvation.

²² You Samaritans worship what you do not know; we worship what we do know, because salvation is from the Jews. John 4:22 NASB

3. is to the Father in spirit and truth.

²³ But a time is coming, and even now has arrived, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks *to be* His worshipers. ²⁴ God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.” John 4:23-24 NASB

I appeal to you therefore, brothers [and sisters], by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. ² Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. Romans 12:1-2 ESV
